Beta Theta Pi was founded at Miami University, Oxford, Ohio on August 8, 1839. John Reilly Knox was the promoter of the organization, which was the first fraternity to originate west of the Allegheny Mountains.

Beta is the oldest member of the Miami Triad. There are eighty-nine chapters of the organization throughout the United States and Canada.

The local Beta chapter, Gamma Phi, was



founded in 1907 as the third fraternity on the campus.

Mrs. Ora Parks of Tulsa came to the chapter as hostess in the fall term of 1937.
